Parish Nursing Notes - Connie Seltz, Parish Nurse Coordinator

It is again Influenza season in Minnesota. I just read an article about places in our homes that provide a place for bacteria and viruses to grow, places sometimes forgotten. Consider:

- 1. That sponge in the kitchen sink. Change it regularly, or get it wet and heat it for 60 seconds in the microwave, or send it through a dishwasher cycle.
- 2. The remote. The article suggested that it is the dirtiest article in our homes. Wipe it regularly with a cleaning product safe for electronics. That goes for the "mouse" and other electronics too!
- 3. The phone. Look carefully! This may be a shocking discovery if it hasn't been cleaned recently!
- 4. Door knobs and handles on kitchen cupboards collect debris from normal kitchen activities.
- 5. The reusable grocery bags. Wash often as they become contaminated from both the inside and outside.
- 6. Mittens, scarves, and gloves. Do wash and dry them whenever soiled and several times during and after the winter season.
- 7. The hands. Do the "elbow bump" instead of shaking hands if you're recovering from a cough or cold. Clean hands are the best infection control practice!




Mystery Dinner
