For where two or three are gathered together in My name, I am there in their midst.

Matthew 18:20

This is one of my favorite Scriptures. It means that whenever two or three of God's children gather to do God's work in God's name, Christ himself is present. What a marvelous thing! It means that Christ plays with us at Kid's Club. Christ builds with us at the Habitat for Humanity site. Christ talks and laughs with us over coffee. Christ teaches us at Bible studies. Christ sings with the choir, rings with the bells, and gives praise with the band. Christ eats with us at church suppers. Christ cries with us at funerals. Christ rejoices with us at baptisms. Christ smiles with us at weddings. Christ worships with us.

Our God is a relational God. A Triune God of Creator, Christ, and Spirit who lives, dwells, and acts in conversation and community. That relationality extends to us. We are part of God's great community.

When we gather on Rally Sunday, September 9th, I want us to remember that Christ is present, too. I want us to remember what two or three people, gathered in Christ's name can accomplish through this community, the Federated Church.

I recently spent several days working the Habitat site. My first day, we framed the walls for an entire house! It is amazing what a few faithful, dedicated, hard-working people can accomplish in a day.

Now, multiply that by the membership of our congregation. If two or three disciples can accomplish great things, just imagine what 20 or 30 can do! Or 200 or 300 can do! That's a lot of hands and heads and hearts working for Christ's kingdom.

Rally Day is traditionally the kickoff for the church school year. We "rally" after taking some time out during the summer to spur one another on to bigger and greater things for Christ. But we're not in this alone: when two or three of us work together, Christ is with us.

The apostle Paul wrote, "I can do all things through Christ who gives me strength" (Philippians 4:13). This means that when two or three gather in Christ's name, we can do anything!

I know Federated Folk will do great things this year, because we are disciples of Jesus Christ, working in his name, for his kingdom, and able to accomplish anything!

May God bless us this year!

Local Mission

Thank you for your continued generosity with the Local Mission Fund! Those who are helped by this fund are extremely grateful for the extra support they receive during tough times. According to our policy, we are able to help each family or individual three times during a 12 month period, with up to \$100 a time, depending on funds. We assist with food, utilities, rent, and, in emergency situations, a night at a hotel. Donations can be put in the offering plate with Local Mission Fund in the memo line or dropped off in the church office. Thank you!



During August, we were able to help 4 families or individuals from the local mission fund. We gave a total of \$250.00 for food, rent and utilities.

QPR and Shatter the Silence

Back in May, Federated hosted an ACE training event to better understand Self-Healing communities. Now, in September, we have 2 new opportunities to raise awareness and better understand our mental and physical well being.

- 1. On September 13th at 7pm, Federated will host a QPR (Question Persuade and Refer) training event. OPR is the CPR of mental health. Maria Willits will cover myths and facts about suicide, warning signs of suicide, ways to apply QPR and ways to offer hope and support. Everyone is invited!
- 2. The other opportunity is Shatter The Silence on September 29th in Fergus Falls. This is the 2nd annual luminary 5k sponsored by Lake Region Healthcare. Illuminate the evening to promote resources and awareness around issues of suicide. Registration begins at 5pm with the run starting at 6pm. The 1/2 5k beings at 7:30pm. Proceeds for the event go to areas schools and communities for suicide awareness and prevention education.
