- 4. What strange sight did King Nebuchadnezzar see in the fiery furnace? (He saw a fourth person walking in the furnace with the three men.)
- 5. What did King Nebuchadnezzar now think about the God of those three men? (He believed the God of the Jews should be respected by everyone.)
