Christian Education and Youth Rev. Karen Anderson

September kicked off with lots of activity here at Federated Church! We made a great start with Kidz Club, Sunday School, confirmation, senior high youth group, and women's Bible study! This is shaping up to be a busy, wonderful year! Here are some highlights and events looking forward.

Kidz Club

Every year we launch a new theme for Kidz Club. This year for 2022-2023 is—God's Big Story! Each Wednesday we gather for snack, gym time, music, craft, and hear a new portion of God's story as He lovingly revealed (and reveals!) Himself to His people through the Bible. We started at the very beginning and will work our way through significant chronological events as recorded in God's word, finding the ways God tells HIS-STORY to us. There are wonderful kids, awesome volunteers, and a delicious supper following for families to relax and break bread together. It isn't too late to come join us on Wednesdays. We are always happy to add new faces to our group.

Sunday School (K-6)

Sunday school began mid-way through September, and we are excited to share that we seem to be adding children each week. Our theme for fall 2022 (with the K-6 students) is "The Lord's Prayer", and we are learning not only the meaning and ideas in the Lord's Prayer; we are discovering the importance of prayer itself in our relationship with God. We are all invited, through Jesus Christ, to have a close relationship with God in which we can share our joys and troubles and seek His plans for us. We hope to encourage our young people to begin or continue their own relationship with God in Jesus Christ through our time together.

Sunday School (7-12)

Our older youth, who meet in the Narthex after worship, are also learning some fascinating ideas together this year. Hollis Davenport, the teacher for the older youth, is focusing on studying sayings and common ideas that ARE in the Bible as well as ones that we THINK are in the Bible but are not. This class is a time of fun discovery and a deeper understanding of God's word in our world!

Sunday School (Pre-K)

Cindy Spidahl begins our once-a-month Pre-K and Parents, or Early Childhood Sunday school class, on Sunday, October 2, in the youth room after worship. Cindy has been diligently working to create a loving atmosphere where young children grow up understanding that they are God's beloved. Parents of littles often need encouragement as they embark on the challenges of parenthood. This will be a time of connection and fellowship for parents as they raise children deeply loved by them and God!

Senior High Youth Group

Our youth group continues to grow in number and in spirit as we come together each Wednesday at 7:30 for bible study, topic discussions, and games. Our leaders, Hollis Davenport, Molly Stoddard, and Madalyn Dent, are there to encourage our young people and bring their faith perspectives to our talks. Our youth are just a wonderful bunch of people who love coming together every week to check in and have fellowship. Many have shared that Wednesday is their favorite day of the week, and that they love being able to come in and call Federated their church home. We love that they know they are welcome to be here, and we make sure that everyone understands God's invitation to them for a deep relationship with Him.



Confirmation

As a fun start to the new school year, our confirmation class spent the weekend of September 16-18 at Presbyterian Clearwater Forest for our annual retreat. This year's theme was "The Faith Race" and we studied the ways that our faith life is like a marathon or race, especially as recounted by the Apostle Paul in Hebrews.
