

I can see them out my window: birds! And they are at it again. They are building a nest in my dryer vent. They did this last year, only I didn't realize what was happening. All I knew was that my dryer was hot enough to melt buttons, and yet my clothes never got dry! One day a crew came to clean out the vents throughout the complex where I live, and the bird's nest was discovered. Mystery solved! They explained to me that what dries your clothes is a combination of heat and air flow. Without the air flow, clothes get incredibly hot, but they don't dry.

I have been thinking about this vent blockage as I consider the movement of the Holy Spirit in our lives. You may remember that the Old Testament word for Spirit is Ruach, which literally means wind. The Spirit blows through our lives. Is it possible that we can "build nests" that block the air flow? I wonder.

I think of the nest of the traditions we love. They can be beautiful memories we cherish, or they can become so set in stone and unchangeable that they block the flow of the Spirit. We have no room for anything new. I think about the decisions we make about where we are going to live or even what we are going to eat as another nest. While sometimes those decisions make great sense for a certain season in our lives, if they get wedged into our psyche in a way that can never be altered, they can end up blocking the flow of the Spirit when change is needed.

I like to see a bird build a nest high in a tree! Sheltered from the rain by plenty of leaves and branches, above the reach of most kinds of trouble, but with the rocking wind and plenty of air it seems like the perfect place for a baby bird to grow and one day learn to fly. In our Christian life, we too do best with a faith that soars through the treetops, and is open to the movement of the Spirit, the very breath of God. When we can be budged from our status quo, when we are able to say, "Change is possible!" And when we dare to spread our wings and ride the currents of God's love, we are positioned for a Spirit filled, Spirit energized, Spirit-led adventure!

We studied a Bible story each day that featured different heavenly bodies: the sun, the moon, the stars, the planets, and the earth. Every story revealed both the incredible beauty of God's creation and the unmatchable power of God to control and use these heavenly bodies for His purpose.
