Help with hurricane relief efforts:

Federated members have two opportunities to contribute to relief efforts for the thousands impacted by Hurricanes Helene and Milton.

First, we are supporting Church World Service in its collection of clean-up buckets filled with essential home recovery supplies. Also, we are accepting donations for hurricane relief efforts by our two denominations, PCUSA and UCC.

Through Nov. 24, you'll find envelopes marked "Hurricane Relief" in the church pews. To contribute to denominational fundraising efforts, put your donation in the Hurricane Relief envelope; make your check payable to Federated Church with "hurricane relief" on the memo line.

If you'd like to assemble a cleanup bucket, the desired supplies are listed in the Hurricane Relief pamphlet available in the church pews or in the church office. (The estimated cost of filling a clean-up bucket is \$78.) If you would prefer to make a donation toward the project, make your check payable to Federated Church and put it in the Hurricane Relief envelope with "cleanup bucket" on the memo line. We will use donations to assemble cleanup buckets.
