Jesus said, "It is finished." Then he bowed his head and gave up his spirit. John 19:30

Pastoral Care

Mornings with Jesus

I enjoy reading a daily devotion from Mornings with Jesus, which is a publication of Guideposts magazine, another great source of comfort. Here is a recent devotion written by Becky Alexander.

With my whole heart I have sought You; Oh let me not wander from Your commandments! Psalm 119:10

The word HEART is mentioned more than 500 times in the Bible. I keep a "Heart List," regularly jotting down verses as I discover them. I write the word heart in capitol letters and red ink.

Perhaps my interest in the heart developed during my Dad's four decades of procedures—two open-heart surgeries, a pacemaker, twenty-eight stents, and a defibrillator. Each time, the doctor drew a diagram to explain the plan for repair. I learned about the four chambers of the heart, and asked questions about the atria, the aorta, and the pulmonary artery. I added the "V" terms to my vocabulary: ventricle, vein, valve, and vessel.

When I think of seeking Jesus with my whole spiritual heart, I like to picture the parts of my physical heart. The right atrium takes in oxygen-poor blood; I tell Jesus I am depleted of energy, direction, patience, and love. The right ventricle forces the blood into the lungs to receive oxygen; I ask Jesus to replenish me with those things that I need. The left atrium, like a reservoir, holds the oxygen-rich blood; I thank Jesus for refreshing me and sheltering me in His care. And finally, the left ventricle pumps the blood throughout the body; I pray for Jesus to send me out in His name, sharing His offer of rescue, proclaiming His restoring love.

Someday, my Heart List may inspire me to write a heart devotional book. But for now, I'll continue adding scriptures and following Jesus with all my heart.

Faith Step: Grab a red pen and begin a Heart List with Psalm 119:10. Find two more heart verses today.

Then watch for others in the future.


